



**BAC RESOLUTION DECLARING FAILURE OF BIDDING FOR THE  
PROCUREMENT OF SERVICES OF ISO CERTIFYING BODY  
FOR PHILRICE CES AND BRANCH STATIONS  
PB 23-03-14**

**BAC RESOLUTION No. 16  
Series of 2023**

**WHEREAS**, the Philippine Rice Research Institute advertised the call for bidding for the **Procurement of Services of ISO Certifying Body for PhilRice CES and Branch Stations PB 23-03-14** on the PhilRice Website, PhilGEPS, and at a conspicuous place on the premises of the Philippine Rice Research Institute continuously from **27 June to 18 July 2023**;

**WHEREAS**, the total approved budget for the contract (ABC) is **One Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos Only (P 1,500,000.00)**;

**WHEREAS**, in response to the said advertisements, five (5) prospective bidders were listed in the PhilGEPS document request list: 1) Socotec Certification Philippines, Inc., 2) TÜV Rheinland Philippines, Inc., 3.) JBDC Occupational Health Safety and Environment Consultancy, 4. SGS Philippines, Inc. and 5) Bitsofttechnology Co.;

**WHEREAS**, a Pre-Bid Conference was conducted last 06 July 2023 at 10 a.m. and attended by four (4) prospective bidders: 1) WQA Philippines Inc., 2) TÜV Rheinland Philippines, Inc., 3) TÜV Nord Philippines, Inc., and 4) SGS Philippines, Inc.;

**WHEREAS**, three (3) bidders: 1) SGS Philippines, Inc., 2) TÜV Nord Philippines, Inc., and 3) WQA Philippines Inc., purchased the bidding document and submitted the proposal before the set deadline;

**WHEREAS**, during the submission and opening of bids held last **18 and 19 July 2023**, preliminary examination of bids was conducted. With the assistance of the BAC Secretariat, the BAC opens the first bid envelope to determine each bidder's compliance with the documents required to be submitted for eligibility and the technical requirements, as prescribed in this IRR. The BAC checked each bidder's submitted documents per the checklist of required documents to ascertain if they are all present, using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion, as stated in the Instructions to Bidders.

**WHEREAS**, the three (3) prospective bidders were declared to be **NON-ELIGIBLE** due to the following:

TÜV Nord Philippines, Inc	Rule VIII – Receipt and Opening of Bids  Section 23.1 Revised IRR of RA 9184. Statement of the bidder of all its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any, whether similar or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be bid. All statements shall include all information required in the PBDs prescribed by the GPPB.	<b>Statement of All Ongoing Government and Private Contracts</b> Unsigned list of ongoing and completed projects in the private sector and list of certified government agencies.  Findings: The submitted document did not follow the required format. The data for the status of contract, percentage of accomplishments and value of outstanding contract were missing. Thus, resulting to undetermined cost of ongoing contracts of the company. The list was unsigned and has no attached supporting documents.  Rate: FAILED
WQA Philippines Inc.	Rule VIII – Receipt and Opening of Bids  Section 23.4.1.3 Revised IRR of RA 9184. The bidder must have completed, within the period specified in the Invitation to Bid, an SLCC that is similar to the contract to be bid, and whose value, adjusted to current prices using the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) consumer price indices, must be at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC.	<b>Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC)</b> The submitted document contains three (3) projects of which two (2) are still ongoing and one (1) completed.  The completed project with the Commission of Human Rights (CHR) was amounting to P716,800.00 only.  Findings: The ABC for PB 23-03-14 is P1,500,000.00, the value of the completed project with CHR does not meet the required value of 50% of the ABC.  Rate: FAILED

**NOW, THEREFORE,** We, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee, do hereby RESOLVE as it is hereby **RESOLVED:**

- a) To **DECLARE** the second failure of bidding for the Procurement of Services of ISO Certifying Body for PhilRice CES and Branch Stations under PB 23-03-14;


