**WHEREAS**, the Philippine Rice Research Institute advertised the call for bidding for the **Supply and Delivery of Various Laboratory Supplies and Chemicals for PhilRice CES** under **PB 24-01-08EPA** on the PhilRice Website, PhilGEPS, and at a conspicuous place on the premises of the Philippine Rice Research Institute continuously from **25 November to 18 December 2023**;

**WHEREAS**, the total approved budget for the contract (ABC) is **NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY ONE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED FIFTY THREE PESOS AND 50/100 ONLY (₱ 971,353.50)**;

**WHEREAS**, in response to the said advertisements, seventeen (17) prospective bidders were listed in the PhilGEPS document request list but only seven (7) prospective bidders: 1) Chemline Scientific Corporation, 2) Diamed Enterprises, 3) Belman Laboratories, 4) Mt. Zion Scientific Inc., 5) Noveaulab Asia Corp., 6) Microgenetix Inc., 7) Biotriune Inc. attended the pre-bid conference last 04 December 2023;

**WHEREAS**, there are two (2) prospective bidders: Chemline Scientific Corporation and Microgenetix Inc., purchased the bidding document and submitted the proposal before the set deadline;

**WHEREAS**, during the submission and opening of bids held last **18 December 2023**, both bidders were rated **PASSED** in the technical and financial component and declared to be **ELIGIBLE**;

**WHEREAS**, the financial proposal of the **above bidders** who passed the technical and financial component were found to be substantially complying and read as follows:
