



**BAC RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING ACTIONS FOR THE
SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF LABORATORY CHEMICALS, SUPPLIES, AND MATERIALS
FOR CORPORATE PROJECTS (4th Quarter)
PB 24-03-33**

**BAC RESOLUTION No. 44
Series of 2024**

WHEREAS, the Philippine Rice Research Institute advertised the call for bidding for the Supply and Delivery of Laboratory Chemicals, Supplies, and Materials for Corporate Projects (4th Quarter) PB 24-03-33 on the PhilRice Website, PhilGEPS, and at a conspicuous place on the premises of the Philippine Rice Research Institute continuously from **09 August to 03 September 2024**;

WHEREAS, the total approved budget for the contract (ABC) is Two Million Five Hundred Sixty Thousand Five Hundred Pesos Only (₱2,560,500.00);

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisements, twenty-four (24) prospective bidders were listed in the PhilGEPS document request list namely: 1) Golden Bat (Far East), Inc., 2) Molave Trading Incorporated, 3) Belman Compania Incorporada Doing Business under the name of Belman Laboratories, 4) Alcaport Trade, 5) Mt. Zion Scientific, Inc., 6) Glenwood Technologies International, Inc., 7) Biotriune, Inc., 8) Chemline Scientific Corporation, 9) EliasaPH Diagnostics Solutions Inc., 10) Chemoscience Phils. Inc., 11) Labotech Trading, 12) Mettler - Toledo Philippines, Inc., 13) Pro Maintech Consultancy Inc., 14) Microgenetix Inc., 15) Noveaulab Asia Corp., 16) Xprt Ventures Incorporated, 17) Lifeline Diagnostics Supplies, Inc., 18) Krypton International Resources Sales & Services Inc., 19) MMJ Biosystems Philippines, Inc., 20) CM Vargas Enterprise, 21) Analytical and Sample Prep Machines Inc., 22) LB2 Laboratory Supplies, 23) Blue Diamond Global Ventures Corp, and 24) Endure Medical, Inc.;

WHEREAS, a Pre-Bid Conference was conducted on 19 August 2024 at 1:30 P.M. and attended by twelve (12) prospective bidders namely, 1) Rainphil Inc., 2) Chemoscience Phils. Inc., 3) Diamed Enterprise, 4) Chemline Scientific Corp., 5) Levins International Inc., 6) Biotriune Inc., 7) Kinovett Scientific Solutions Co., 8) Belman Laboratories, 9) Microgenetix Inc., 10) Mt. Zion Scientific Inc., 11) Lifeline Diagnostics Supplies Inc., and 12) Pro Maintech Consultancy. Inc.;

WHEREAS, on 28 August 2024, **Bid Bulletin No. 1** was issued to reflect changes in Sections VI and VII of the Schedule of Requirements and Technical Specifications;

WHEREAS, a total of eight (8) bidders purchased the bidding documents and submitted their proposals before the deadline. The bidders are as follows: 1) Chemline Scientific Corp., 2) CAS Color Application Specialist, 3) Microgenetix, Inc., 4) Krypton International Resources Sales & Services Inc., 5) Lifeline Diagnostics Supplies Inc., 6) Mt. Zion Scientific Inc., 7) Biotriune Inc., and 8) Diamed Enterprise;

WHEREAS, during the bid opening held on **04 September 2024**, at **10:30 A.M.**, a preliminary examination of bids was conducted. With the assistance of the BAC Secretariat, the BAC opened the first bid envelope to determine each bidder's compliance with the required documents for eligibility and technical requirements as prescribed in the IRR. The BAC checked each bidder's submitted document against the checklist of required documents



to ensure they were all present, using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as stated in the Instructions to Bidders;

WHEREAS, during the opening of the technical component one (1) bidder, Diamed Enterprise was declared **FAILED** by the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC). Diamed Enterprise failed to comply with the required Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) that should have been completed within two (2) years prior to the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids;

WHEREAS, the financial proposals of the bidders who passed the technical component, and financial component were found to be substantially complying and read as follows:

WHEREAS, on 06 September 2024, the BAC received a letter from Diamed Enterprise through an electronic mail filing for a motion for reconsideration based on the following:

Requirement	Findings & Recommendation
As per Clause 10.2 of the Bidding Documents, the Bidder's SLCC as indicated in ITB Clause 5.3 should have been completed within two (2) years prior to the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids.	Diamed Enterprise submitted an SLCC amounting to ₱5,415,000.00 completed on February 12, 2021, which is more than three years before the bid submission deadline Recommendation: DENY the motion for reconsideration.



WHEREAS, on 09 September 2024, the BAC resolved to **DENY** Diamed Enterprise’s motion for reconsideration;

WHEREAS, during the post-qualification evaluation, upon careful examination, verification, validation, and ascertainment of all statements and representations made, including all documents submitted for the bidding of the above bidders were found to be complying with the eligibility documents required;

WHEREAS, following the post-qualification evaluation of the technical specifications, the results were as follows:
