



**BAC RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING AWARD FOR THE
SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF AGRICULTURAL SUPPLIES FOR DA-PHILRICE
BDD PB 25-01-04A**

**BAC RESOLUTION No. 04
Series of 2025**

WHEREAS, the Philippine Rice Research Institute advertised the call for bidding for the Supply and Delivery of Agricultural Supplies for DA-PhilRice BDD PB 25-01-04A on the PhilRice Website, PhilGEPS 1.5, and at a conspicuous place on the premises of the Philippine Rice Research Institute continuously from **20 December 2024 to 20 January 2025** with a total approved budget for the contract (ABC) for One Million Eight Hundred Forty One Thousand Three Hundred Twenty Two and 56/100 Pesos Only (₱1,841,322.56);

WHEREAS, in response to the said advertisements, thirteen (13) prospective bidders were listed in the PhilGEPS document request list namely: 1) RTC Laboratory Services and Supply House, 2) Universal Harvester, Inc., 3) DRREF Agri Products Marketing, 4) Sentinel Plastic Manufacturing Corporation, 5) Providers Multi-Purpose Cooperative, 6) Enviro Scope Synergy Inc, 7) Mikai Agri Trading, 8) YCC Enterprise, OPC., 9) Emo Agri Sales and Marketing, Inc., 10) Zion Agricultural Ventures Inc., 11) St Raphael Agri Trading, 12) Pacific 77 Trading OPC., and 13) S & P Enterprises, Inc.;

WHEREAS, there were four (4) bidders: 1) S & P Enterprises, Inc., 2) YCC Enterprise, OPC., 3) Mikai Agri Trading, and 4) EMO Agri Sales and Marketing purchased the bidding document and submitted the proposal before the set deadline;

WHEREAS, during the opening of bids, a preliminary examination of bids was conducted. With the assistance of the BAC Secretariat, the BAC opened the first bid envelope to determine each bidder's compliance with the documents required to be submitted for eligibility and the technical requirements, as prescribed in the IRR. The BAC checked each bidder's submitted documents per the checklist of required documents to ascertain if they are all present, using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion, as stated in the Instructions to Bidders;

WHEREAS, on 20 January 2025, during the opening of the bids, the BAC upon careful examination of the submitted eligibility and technical documents, declared the bid of **EMO Agri Sales and Marketing** as "FAILED" due to non-submission of the latest Mayor's Permit. Annex A of PhilGEPS Platinum Registration Certificate indicates that the Mayor's Permit already expired last December 31, 2024, which is a non-compliance with Section 23.1 of the Revised IRR of RA9184;

WHEREAS, EMO Agri Sales and Marketing filed a motion for Reconsideration on 22 January 2025 for their disqualification during the opening of bids;

WHEREAS, the BAC through BAC Resolution No. 03 Series of 2025, denied the Motion for Reconsideration since Emo Agri submitted a suspended PhilGEPS Platinum Registration Certificate due to the expired Mayor's Permit, the BAC declared the bid as "failed" in compliance with the "pass/fail" criteria;

WHEREAS, the offer for item No. 8 of YCC Enterprises, OPC was post-disqualified due to non-compliance with a valid product registration certificate;



WHEREAS, following the bid evaluation and post-qualification process, the BAC determined that the bid submitted by YCC Enterprise, OPC., Mikai Agri Trading, and S&P Enterprises, Inc. were found to be complying with the eligibility and technical specifications required, the results were as follows:


Item no./Particulars	Evaluation	Recommendation
Item numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 9, and 10	The offer of the lowest bidders is compliant with the required technical specifications and is within the approved budget per item.	Items No. 1 to 4, & 6 are to be awarded to S & P Enterprises Inc., Items No. 9 & 10 to YCC Enterprises, OPC, and Item No. 5 to Mikai Agricultural Trading.
Item No. 7	S & P Enterprises Inc., & Mikai Agricultural Trading quoted the same price for Item No. 7 - to break the tie a toss coin was implemented.	Item no. 7 is to be awarded to S & P Enterprises Inc. as a result of a toss coin.
Item number 8	The offer of YCC Enterprises is not compliant with the required technical specifications (other requirements).	To be procured through an Alternative Mode of Procurement- Negotiated Procurement.


NOW, THEREFORE, We, the Members of the Bids and Awards Committee, do hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED**:
